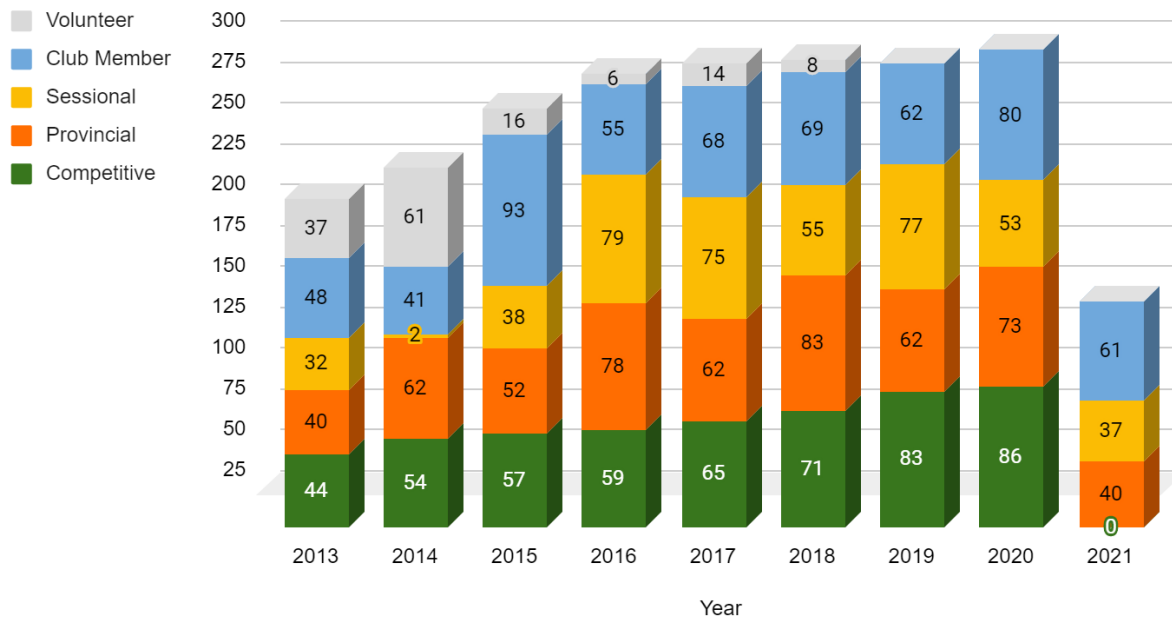

NOTES:

- Numbers are based on WPS's invoices to RWPA for the year ending in the spring (ex. 2020 is for the 2019/2020 season)
- 2021 Membership
 - 16 Elite Boys/Men
 - normally competitive members as they play NCL with TeamSask
 - will be provincial members as out of province competition is not allowed
 - 19 Elite Girls/Women
 - normally competitive members as they play NCL with TeamSask

- will be provincial members as out of province competition is not allowed
 - 19 Battleship
 - normally competitive members as they played 14U NCL with RWPA and to be eligible for Alberta Open with TeamSask
 - will be club members as PL events & provincials are not allowed
 - 14 Admiral
 - most are normally competitive members to be eligible for Alberta Open with TeamSask
 - will be club members as PL events & provincials are not allowed
 - 14 Semi-Competitive
 - normally provincial members as they play in PL events & provincials
 - will be club members as PL events & provincials are not allowed
 - 18 Seals participated in the fall session
 - 19 Pups participated in the fall session
 - 19 BAP/RAP (14 club members) and CAP (5 provincial)
 - most are normally provincial members as they play in provincials
 - normally any CAP players that play NCL with TeamSask are competitive members
 - The Carrier program is not offered for the 2020/21 season.
- 2020 Membership based on WPS's invoice to RPWA (Apr 18, 2020)
 - 86 competitive includes Battleship, Carrier, Elite & CAP
 - 73 provincial includes ILWP who played PL events, as well as Semi Comp, Admiral (Alberta Open was not held last year due to COVID) & BAP/RAP
 - 53 sessional are ILWP who did not play in any PL events
 - 80 club includes BAP/RAP who did not play in provincials, and includes minor officials, volunteers & referees
 - there are 95 names on this invoice that were not on the previous year's invoice
 - 2019 numbers are from WPS's invoice to RWPA (May 28, 2019)
 - RWPA introduced the semi comp program for the 2014/15 season
 - 2013-2018 numbers are from an inquiry to WPS
